The successful candidate will lead our sediment & soil ecotoxicology team located in Lausanne, actively interact with the team in Dübendorf, and participate in national and international expert groups.

Candidates should have a doctoral degree in environmental or natural sciences, and at least six years of professional experience in applied ecotoxicology. The ideal candidate will have broad research and consulting experience in terrestrial ecotoxicology with special emphasis on environmental fate and bioavailability of chemicals. Experience in analytical chemistry, a regulatory work environment and collaborations with stakeholders is a plus. We expect demonstrated experience in independent project planning and management, experimental design and statistical data analysis. The ability to work as part of a team, good verbal and written communication skills, excellent organizational skills, and experience in guiding junior collaborators are a must. Fluency in spoken and written French and English is required; German language skills are desired.
